Defibrillator to be sited in Newton telephone box – The defibrillator is in place but the cabinet suppliers have sent the wrong model and this will have to be replaced. A parishioner asked if it was possible to leave a telephone in the box as she thought it was an important historical feature. After a general discussion it was agreed that a telephone could be left in the box but it should be clearly marked "not in use".

Water problem in Booth Lane – After a site meeting with a representative of Staffordshire Highways, it was agreed that the Parish Council would purchase the drainage pipe and pay for the excavation and backfill across the field, and Staffordshire Highways would be responsible for laying the pipe across the road.
